• Cestocidal - kills tapeworms.

#### **DOSAGE / ADMINISTRATION**

- If dogs or cats do not readily accept, chew and swallow the tablet, it should be crushed and put on food.
- Give to puppies and kittens every 2 weeks until 12 weeks of age, then monthly until 6 months of age, then give every 3 months.

Weight refers to upper weight of treatment range i.e. 1 tablet per 5 kg (5kg tablet).
