

# EQUIMAX® LV

## BROAD-SPECTRUM WORMER FOR HORSES



A broad-spectrum horse wormer containing ivermectin and praziquantel for the treatment and control of sensitive tapeworms, bots and roundworms.

### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

- Ivermectin 18.7mg/g
- Praziquantel 140 mg/g

### KEY BENEFITS/PROPERTIES

- Highly effective against ALL nematodes and tapeworms of pathological importance in New Zealand.
- Includes arterial stages of *Strongylus vulgaris* and benzimidazole-resistant small strongyles, pinworm, stomach hairworm, intestinal threadworm, ascarids, neck threadworm, large-mouthed stomach worm and lungworm.
- One tube treats up to 700 kg.
- Convenient ergonomic, graduated syringe.
- Safe to use on foals, pregnant mares and breeding stallions.
- LV = lower volume because of a more concentrated formula for easier administration and better compliance.

### MODE OF ACTION

Ivermectin interferes with neurotransmission in the parasite, causing paralysis and death.

Praziquantel causes spastic paralysis and damages the tapeworms' tegument, evoking an immune response. These actions result in both detachment and disintegration of the parasite.

### INDICATIONS

Treatment and control of sensitive strains of tapeworm, roundworm and bot species in horses of all ages.

### PRECAUTIONS

Ensure locking ring is securely locked in place at the correct dose.

### WITHHOLDING PERIOD

Meat: 63 days.

### DOSAGE

The recommended dose rate is 1ml/100kg of bodyweight. The first division delivers enough paste to treat 100 kg. Each subsequent syringe division delivers enough paste to treat 50kg of bodyweight.

Foals: treat initially at 6-8 weeks of age and repeat routinely every 6 weeks until 12 months of age.

Mares: treat 2 weeks before foaling and repeat when the foal is wormed.

Adult Horses: Living in high population densities, or horses that mix regularly with other horses, should be wormed every 8 weeks.

### STORAGE

Store below 25°C.
