ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

- Milbemycin oxime
- Praziquantel

KEY BENEFITS/PROPERTIES

- Highly palatable, small, rounded tablet.
- Certified easy to give by the International Society of Feline Medicine.
- Contains real poultry protein.

MODE OF ACTION

Milbemycin oxime:

- Kills roundworm, hookworm and whipworm.
- Blocks the parasites nerve cells, leading to paralysis and death.

Praziquantel:

- Kills tapeworms.
- Causes integumental disintegration and spasms leading to death.

INDICATIONS

Dogs: For the treatment and control of mixed infections by:

- Roundworm (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*)
- Whipworms (*Trichuris vulpis*)
- Hookworms (*Ancylostoma caninum*)
- Tapeworms (*Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia* spp, *Echinococcus granulosus*)

Cats: For the treatment and control of:

- Roundworms (*Toxocara cati*, *Toxascaris leonina*)
- Hookworms (*Ancylostoma tubaeforme*)
- Tapeworms (*Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia* spp)

CONTRAINDICATIONS

- Do not give to kittens under 6 weeks of age.
- Do not give to puppies or kittens weighing less than 500g.

DOSAGE / ADMINISTRATION

Milpro® for Small Cats & Kittens: 500g

- 1kg: ½ tablet
- 1.1kg - 2kg: 1 tablet

Milpro® for Cats:

- 2kg - 4kg: ½ tablet
- 4.1kg - 8kg: 1 tablet
- 8.1kg - 12 kg: 1 ½ tablets

Milpro® for Small Dogs & Puppies:

- 500g - 1kg: ½ tablet
- 1.1kg - 5kg: 1 tablet
- 5.1kg - 10kg: 2 tablets

Milpro® for Dogs

- 5kg - 25kg: 1 tablet
- 25.1kg - 50kg: 2 tablets
- 50.1kg - 75kg: 3 tablets

STORAGE

Store at room temperature (below 25°C). Keep the blister in the outer carton or envelope. Half tablets should be stored in the original blister and be used within 6 months.

PRESENTATION

Small cats and kittens: 24 tablet bulk pack.
Cat: 48 tablet bulk pack.
Small dogs and puppies: 24 tablet bulk pack.
Dog: 48 tablet bulk pack.

All sizes also available in 2 tablet consumer pack.
