MODE OF ACTION

Praziquantel:

- Kills tapeworms.
- Causes integumental disintegration and spasms leading to death.

DOSAGE / ADMINISTRATION

Administer directly by mouth, or crushed and added to food. Regular dosing is essential for worm control.

Recommended treatment protocols:

Dogs in rural areas (possible contact with sheep and cattle): treat every 4 - 6 weeks. Dogs visiting rural areas: treat within 4 weeks before visiting a rural area. Dogs kept in urban areas: if infestation is detected, treat every 4 weeks for 3 months. For routine prevention, treat every 3 to 6 months. STORAGE

Store below 30°C.
